

Welcome to the 63rd Swiss Two-Day March



Announcement and Regulations 2022

"A march is a call to set something in motion".

We are organising the Swiss Two-Day March on the weekend of **28/29 May 2022** in such a way that all hiking and marching enthusiasts in their region of residence can participate.

The Swiss Two-Day March is the largest hiking and marching event in Switzerland. It has been held since 1960.

There are neither age limits nor target times. You can participate as an individual or as a group.

For uniformed participants in Switzerland, the wearing of the uniform is approved by the SAT (Shooting and Off-Duty Activities).

Uniformed participants abroad must obtain this authorisation themselves in accordance with their regulations.

1. Organiser

Swiss Two-Day March Association, 3000 Bern

2. Routes

The routes must be determined independently in your region of residence. When registering, choose your personal performance target per day. The **distances 10, 20, 30** and 40 km are offered.

3. Registration / Privacy Policy

For registration, it is compulsory to state surname, first name, address, year of birth, nationality and the desired route. The e-mail address will only be used for event-specific information.

When registering third parties, it is assumed that the consent of this person exists.

Data will not be passed on to third parties.

3. March Control - 2TM App

A 2TM app will be provided free of charge to registered persons for the purpose of checking their completed hiking/marching performance.

The 2TM app is free and works on both IOS and Android devices.

If it is not possible to install it on your device, you can use the device of a person marching with you or send in a photo of the pedometer and describe the marched route.

4. Awards

For the award "Swiss Two-Day March" a two-day march with a daily distance of at least 10 km must be completed.

Civilians receive a **pin with the number of completed marches** and **uniformed persons** a **pin in the form of a helmet with the number of completed marches**. For the first, fifth, tenth, 20th, 25th, 30th, 35th and 50th participation, a **medal** will also be awarded.

Each **group** will receive a **Pennant** as a group award.

Awards will be sent out approximately two months after the event.

According to the guidelines of the IML (International Marching League), the participation in this year's Swiss Two-Day March cannot be counted as an **IML ranking**.

For the **IVV/VSL-EVG classification stamp**, the pass must be sent in before the march (Schweizerischer Zweitagemarsch, 3000 Bern). The participation will be stamped and the pass returned. If the route is completed several times, a new start card is required each time.

Valid for 2022 VSL / ECG Code: 2022 901.007.15.22.RK

The march will count towards the **Ribbon "Military Sports Competition Award".** The **military performance certificate** (MLA) must be sent in before the march (Schweizerischer Zweitagemarsch, 3000 Bern). Participation will be stamped and the ID card returned.

5. Start times

There are no set start times. Activate the **2TM app** before you set off. Simply start marching on Saturday 28 or Sunday 29 May 2022 at the local time that suits you. After completing the march route, press the "Stop" button. The marched route is automatically transmitted to the OK.

6. Catering

Everyone is responsible for their own food and drink on the march.

7. Ambulance / Emergency aid

Participation is only recommended with sufficient preparation and good health.

For **urgent emergencies**, we recommend that participants in Switzerland download the **Echo 112** app on their mobile phones before the march. In an emergency situation, the **ambulance** can be requested **directly via the Echo 112** app or telephone 144.

Participants outside Switzerland, please base your request on your national emergency services.

If you press the "Help" button on the 2TM app, the OC of the Swiss Two-Day March will be informed that you need help. For domestic participants, we will try to contact them directly to coordinate assistance. For foreign participants, we will try to inform the local rescue service. The Swiss Two-Day March Association does not guarantee that help can be organised. In any case, you will have to bear or arrange for the costs incurred in connection with the rescue yourself.

8. Insurance

Insurance is the responsibility of the participants. The Swiss Two-Day March Association declines all liability.

9. Login - Registration

Online registration for the 63rd Swiss Two-Day March will open at the beginning of April 2022 on the website <u>www.2tm.ch.</u>

Registration deadline: 27 May 2021

The registration is successfully completed with the payment. Subsequent

registrations and mutations are possible after this date.

If a registered person cannot start or declares his/her non-participation to the organiser beforehand, there is no right to a refund of the entry fee.

10. Start and finish area / Accommodation / Arrival / Parking facilities

Covid-19 conditional, there is no start/finish area. No accommodation or parking will be provided.
